

This, I believe, takes place by what you say and do; how you carry yourself, the kind of character and integrity that you live your life by. How you speak of your relationship with God only has to come from your heart. Let the relationship that you have with God, come forth for all to experience. Let the ways that Lord of Life is meaningful to you be known as well. This is a special place for multiple reasons. First and foremost is because of God's presence in this place. Secondly, is because all of you. It is a joy for me to speak of our God, and also a joy to speak of this place that does so many wonderful things for others as an expression of God's presence on all of our journeys with Him.

Many were like little children comparing and sharing the different valentines that they received with each other. I had an officer say that his men needed the cards more than he, but I assured him that we had enough for everyone. As they departed to board their plane, there were more "thank you's" and smiles that day than we had had in a long time.
