

Welcome to our new leaner, less expensive newsletter! As you know we are penny pinching and the distribution of the newsletter is one area that needed some trimming. If someone you know needs or wants a printed copy, they can ask Becci for one and then pick it up at church. We can no longer afford to use a bulk mailing permit. It's cost and minimum numbers no longer are cost effective for us.

It is a new year in many ways. A year ago I came to help you redevelop your congregation back into a thriving, growing witness of Christ's love to the community. Life has a way of complicating things and it is easy to forget the purpose for draining the pond when alligators

are distracting you! Remembering that distraction is one of Satan's most favorite tactics.

Having been sick the last week and being made to stay in and down to get well has given me time to reflect n my purpose in your presence. I went over my notes from my Redevelopment Training and renewed my personal commitment to aid you as was our common purpose a year ago.

We have a firmer grip on our finances and will be greatly challenged this year. But God loves a challenge and especially loves the beloved who step up to the challenging, even if haltingly so.

The next step is to convene a group of passionate people willing to research, learn, advocate, lead, and dare to suggest changes. Changes are not necessarily permanent, but they do require an honest effort for a reasonable amount of time. I do not know who those passionate people are yet. We will find out together. Our first meeting will be on March 21 at 1 PM in the library. If you cannot make daytime meetings but want to be part of this, let's talk and we'll negotiate a better time.

At this first meeting I will present the overall redevelopment process to you. Then volunteers will step forward for the first step of information gathering and we'll be off!

Having a process to follow is nice but it will be totally ineffective if we do not also commit to partner with God on this. That means a special Bible study. We will schedule that for Sunday mornings after the service and all can participate. This does not replace either the Tuesday morning or Saturday morning Bible study. This is special in that it focuses on God's call to us as a congregation. We will begin this special Bible study the first Sunday AFTER Easter.

It is difficult, time consuming work to redevelop a congregation when you have a full-time trained pastor. It is exponentially more difficult when you have a part time trained pastor. But we will work with what God has provided and God will provide the results as well. Now is the time, a well-worn, often overworked cliché, but true none the less.
