

Thank you, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit: for Lord of Life Lutheran Church in Moreno Valley and for the solid ministry so evident here; for the Christian Love in caring for one another in this family of God; for the Spirit of holiness and the openness to God's work; for the enthusiasm in worship and music and reverence of the sacrament of the Lord's Supper.

The message above I sent to you September, 2007 and now in May, 2011, I repeat it and add a resounding "AMEN!" At our Good Friday Tenebrae Service, the Christ Candle was lighted symbolizing Christ's resurrection from the dead and His blessed promise "whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die." This candle continues to be lighted through Pentecost Sunday, June 12th.

Pentecost is the third great festival of our Christian year, celebrating the gift of the Holy Spirit and the birth of the community of faith, the Christian Church. The word "Pentecost" means 50th (day) in Greek and commemorates the descent of the Spirit upon the apostles 50 days after Jesus' resurrection.

We are only, in our day, relearning what it means for the Church to think of ourselves as people of the Spirit, with the Spirit of God as our special gift. We are the people of God among whom God's own Spirit dwells; as that Spirit spoke to the prophets of old; as that Spirit animated the life and ministry of God's son, Jesus; so that same Spirit is now our own comfort, counselor, guide and advocate just as Christ promised. Red is the color for Pentecost symbolizing the tongues of fire, and the blood of the martyrs.

So, come celebrate the Holy Spirit at Lord of Life Lutheran Church Sunday, June 12th, and enjoy a pot-luck brunch with us following the Communion Service.

Lord of Life will be hosting Life Line Screening on Monday, June 27th, 2011. Life Line will be screening for blockages in the carotid arteries, abdominal aortic aneurysm, and peripheral arterial disease. They will also do an EKG, and osteoporosis risk assessment. This is a preventative program for anyone over the age of 40 and it is worth participating in. Your screening results are sent to you within 21 days after they are reviewed by a board certified physician, and you are then able to take those results to your own personal physician. These low cost, non-invasive, completely painless screenings take about 10 minutes each. You must pre-register by calling 1-800-324-1851 for an appointment.
